

February 1941

Sat 1 continued very mild I drove and got our mail a number of people around town and a few trucks busy taking wheat to Dawson Creek Clear and Mild to night

Sun 2 Very mild all day Mr. Mikkelson & 3 children came for a visit from the Pine River

Mon 3 30 Above this morning. I drove to town this morning with some mail Very mild all day

Tue 4 31 Above this morning and mild all day some men left here today to work on the road from here to Pt Nelson they are going to build a log house for freight at Huddup they expect to get to Pt Nelson by 1st April. Duncan left to night to work for them
24 Above to night

Wed 5 continued fine mild weather Fred got back last night a few trucks hauling freight to Huddup for the road party Fred got the mail

Thu 6 26 Above this morning and fine and mild all day Fred cut and fire wood for potatoes self and John they saw Mayan still working at the airport clear and a little colder to night wind from North
