

April 1941

- Mon 7 A hard frost last night but very warm all day I drove over with some mail this morning Fred working at Thorsens blowing a chinook this afternoon
- Tue 8 A fine clear day Blowing a chinook all day the snow going fast Fred working at Thorsens
- Wed 9 continued very mild Fred finished work at Thorsens he then went for the mail but he could not cross the River as the ice was running Day cloudy all afternoon
- Thu 10 A fine clear day Duncan arrived by plane from Ft Nelson where he had been working on the road Very hot all day a rumour that the ice is running
- Fri 11 Weather fine Blowing a strong West Wind the snow nearly all gone the ground drying up fast Fred working at Johns place very cold to night Wind from North
- Sat 12 A fine warm day I drove over for the mail I met Frank who came home for a visit there was 2 other soldiers along with him they get 14 day leave Frank is looking well We did not get the mail until late to night 4 air Plains landed here today
