- Tue 20 A hard frost last night but very mild all day. A number of trucks hauling freight to Ft Nelson they going as far as Sittling just now and from there to Ft Nelson later this is government freight for the Air Base landing at Ft Nelson
- Wed 21 A hard frost last night but very mild all day. Fred splitting fire wood. He went for the mail after dinner.
- Thu 22 Frost last night, a fine clear day but not thawing. Fred splitting fire wood. Duncan arrived ~~by~~ by Plain from Ft Nelson this morning he got hurt and was sent in to see the doctor
- Fri 23 Cold this morning Duncan went over to see Dr. Karmay. Very mild all day. Fred at school
- Sat 24 A fine, mild day, Fred splitting wood. We drove over and got the mail. Cloudy to night.
- Sun 25 Cloudy and overcast this morning. Snowed a little during last night.
- Mon 26 Snowed a little last night or early this morning. All day. Fred splitting wood.
