men working at the Dredge trying to raise
it up

Thursday 2

Continues fine self at odd jobs
Cadenhead passed down the River
with his motor Boat self busy with
Indians a few white men around

Friday 3

Self at odd jobs weather fine
River dropping fast

Saturday 4

a fine warm day very little
doing

Sunday 5

Weather fine an Indian arrived
from the Davis outfit at Clear
hills

Monday 6

Leisure day self in office
2 men & a little girl passed down in
a canoe this evening the boys finished hogging

Tuesday 7

a fine clear day self in office
water quiet down people busy
cutting three beams on top of the
hill 3 men & 2 women passed
down the River to P.R. King
