Tuesday 28 November

A fine clear day but cold the boys
went for hay self at old fish mound
the place a lot of ice running

Wednesday 29

A fine mild day self fixing up
a place for the chickens in the
stable as the hen house is so cold
a lot of ice going down but
no harm as yet George went for
a load of hay

Thursday 30

Blowing a strong Chinook wind
self very busy B.C. Brady arrived
from up the Halpuz River report
very little fur

Friday 1st December 1916

Continues fine weather self at old
fish mound cutting fire wood
River clear of ice

Saturday 2

Continues fine weather self
busy in office Boys handling fire
wood cloudy towards evening
and looks like snow

Sunday 3

a light fall of snow this morning
but cleared up later on
The mail arrived this evening
from Carleton Place. Ogline brought
it over in his car along with
the 2 Policemen

Monday 4

Self in office all the men from the
flat was up after their mail
quite a crowd arrived continues
fine very little ice running
