The last day of the year
a lot of Indians arrived and
brought a lot of Deer a number of them
paid their debt. Self busy all day
Attachee arrived around from up
Caska Creek

MON. January 1 1917
Monday

Newyears day. Self very busy
with Indians all day. Substantially
others left this morning for their Camps
a fine clear day

Tuesday

Self busy in store most of the
Indians gone. Cold and stormy
with snow

Wednesday 3

Cold & stormy with snow. Self
clearing up store. The last of the
Indians left this morning. The
mail arrived this evening from
Bunce Camp

Thursday 4

Continues cold as below the mean.
A lot of people arrived for the mail
Self very busy. Paper arrived from
Halpury Prince
