Friday 26

Cold & stormy all day with snow
very little during fell about 8ⁱⁿ snow
and snow still falling

Saturday 27

Continues cold and stormy
with snow. Very cold towards
evening self at oil jobs

Sunday 28

Continues cold & stormy all day
Mr Dykes arrived from H. Hope
about 2 o'clock in afternoon

Monday 29

fine and clear but cold
5^o below this morning self with
with Mr Dykes

Tuesday 30 January 1917

Continues very cold Mr Dykes
& Man left this morning for
Grande Prairie. 5^o below this
morning self & Johnny handling
fire wood. Two Indians arrived
from Myasteging camp.

Wednesday 31

Continues very cold 5^o below this
morning self & Johnny handling wood
the Indians left this morning after
getting a few supplies

February 1st 1917

Thursday 1st

Self & Johnny went down the
River with the team and made
a trail for the boys we turned
back from below Taylor flat
snowing all day
