Wednesday 25

Continues fine weather self
at old jobs around the place
P. Inshell around on the other
side of the river

Thursday 26

Continues fine weather 2 Indians
arrived from Montezuma Camp
3 days with they brought a few
beads self in store & secured
20 acres of oats on top of the
hill.

Friday 27

The Indians left this morning
self at old jobs the ice broke
on the river this evening but
churned in the bend

Saturday 28

Continues fine self in office
a lot of ice going down the
river but still churned in the
bend

April 1917

Sunday 29

Sett 1 hen with 12 eggs this
morning Cold & stormy with
snow all day

Monday 30

a fine clear day self in office
the ice still holding in the
bend

Tuesday, 1st May 1917

a fine clear day self in office
the ice still churned in the
bend. Blowing a strong gale
of wind from the north
Mr & Mrs Peely went to live up
at their Homestead. Started to
snow this evening

Wednesday 2

snow this morning with a cold
north wind self in office at home
made a trip down river another
pen & buyer around
