Self busy with Indians Samson after
Harris the Indian left at noon
to Yulion left for Bushy River this
morning

THURSDAY, 8 (11-355)

Self started to plow the garden
Samson dinner
a Noakiak arrived from
the South Pine River

FRIDAY, 9 (12-354)

Self as yesterday requested some oats
in afternoon & Langseth arrived
from the Hope
old Mack came down
from the Island Carbonhead
arrived from Halpin River
