back to search for

(238-128)

1912

cold & stormy 3 men arrived on
a raft from H Hope

MONDAY, 26

(239-127)

a fine clear day. Look clearly
towards evening and a little to rain
Self very busy in store
Mr. Prochford
& party of 6 men arrived from the
interior and are going to look over
the country north of here
Several of the
few H. Hope Indians arrived from
Hing River

TUESDAY, 27

(240-126)

Self busy with Indians
a fine mild day look clearly
at the mountains
