left for H.H.P.

Thursday 2
Self & George went down the River and
cut fire wood continued cold

Friday 3
Self in office 3 Indians arrived from
the Halpung station a fine clear
day but cold water rising passed
down here on his way to River Camp
for water

Saturday 4
Self busy with Indians a fine clear
day Badenhead & De Green arrived from
P.B. King the mail got in this evening
Markes came up from the flat and put
up his furs for sale Reuilbons got the lot
