Thurs 12 finished planting potatoes & day Friday 13 putting up fencing & cutting rails

Sat 14 Learn Baptist hauling fence rails Blowing a gale of wind with showers.

Sun 15 Fence & Lumbermen front last night Mon 16 finished putting up the fence Learn Baptist hauling rails

Tue 17 busy working in the office Learn Baptist last night at odd jobs

Wed 18 a few more ~~before~~ before

Thurs 19 went up the River for Logs for building

Friday 20 Busy taking logs out of river

Saturday 21 Inspection & Char. Cuthbertson

Sunday 22 Inspection & Char. started work today

Monday 23 a fine warm day

Tuesday 24 started to lay the foundation of the Depot Learn Baptist putting up fence

Wed 25 working at building Learn Baptist hauling lumber

Wed 25 same as before.

Water arrived to make for the lumber.

Thurs 26 working at building Learn Baptist working

the building very hot weather the River rising fast

Friday 27 same as yesterday

very hot River high
