high.
- 11 Fine day at last. working in the
potatoes field
- 12 at same job. crossed the river
with Sam White to get some of
his flour.
13. Fine weather. Sam White & Pat went
up the hill
- 14 Very hot day. Carter & Fred brought
down a raft to go down
- 15 Very warm weather. Mac Fee's
men arrived with some more
loads.
- 16 Sunday. Beautiful day.
- 17 Mac Fee's men started for
Peace River Landing. very hot.
- 18 Fine weather. Mac Fee & Rite came
down from the Staps. Left
D^r. Potts on the other side of the
fortage
- 19 Rain a little. the water
falling fast
20. D^r. Potts party arrived from the
Staps. saw him about 40 miles up
the river. fine day very warm.
- 21 The same party left for P. R. L.
on a small boat.
- 22 Rain a little in the middle of the day
nothing doing. the water falling fast
- 23 Sunday.
- 24 Rain last night. very fine
weather. Mac Fee & Rite started
over land for Lewis Slaw Lake
No Khondy here, around, very quiet.
