 Fri 5 Beasts around and started back again
 Sat 6 opening grounds
 Sun 7 a fine day with a strong gale of wind
 Mon 8 Bleeding a strong gale of wind self on
 Tues 9 Wm McDermott laying out the H. Hoke outfit
 Wed 10 Mr McDermott laying up his outfit
 Thurs 11 fine warm day across Mack's & Rappert's
 Fri 12 Mr McDermott as before
 Sat 13 shipping the outfit
 Sun 14 shipping the outfit
 Mon 15 busy around the place put up the fly stuff
 Tues 16 a fine day rain towards evening
 Wed 17 a lot of Indians around but rather started
 of rain last night
 Thurs 18 snow last night away working around
 the place Napoleon around
