Monday 18

a fine clear day the boys all have
put up a few better boats towards
evening

Tuesday 19

a fine clear day put up 10 tons of
Hay

Wednesday 20

Cloudy the D.A. Thomas arrived
and brought up a dredge 5 miles
on the bars of the River with a crew
of 10 men Rain again towards evening

Thursday 21

The steam unladen a little tonight
and left for P.B. taking the Pine Pass
around in afternoon and continued
on to H. Hope Rain nearly all day
self very busy

Friday 22

Rain this morning self in store
a few people arrived

Saturday 23

a fine clear day self very busy
Redfern & Suppin arrived from the
relation where they have been prospecting
all summer but found nothing
a few men arrived with over 60 horses
from P.B. they over land the Pine Pass
went down this afternoon
