Saturday 2
a hard frost last night some potatoes
frozen. I did some work at the
Well and we made the Crabbie
cloudy and a few showers all day
the Boys came over and helped

this evening

Sunday 3
Snowed all last night and nearly
all day, fell about 6 in of snow
very cold this evening wind N to

Monday 4
a labor day but the raining but dried
towards noon. My 5 Fred working at
the Well cold towards evening
I expect that nearly all the Crops
are frozen

Tuesday 5
Cold last night and continued
cold all day a lot of snow on the
ground yet I drove down to the
Ranch no snow down there the
Garden looks good very little of it
froze I got back at 6 this evening
nearly all the Crops down and
will be hard to cut with the Binder
