The fossils along with the fish & bones went out after the school found them up at Sabine Creek. Unfortunately they & 2 boys who were had brought a few more.

WEDNESDAY 22 (83-283)

Left of looking for horses all day but could not find them. He would while out of his traps & traps having seen the animals twice about 1/2 mile back from here. All in good condition.

SATURDAY 25 (86-280)

The specimens started back this morning but at odd jobs.
